New & Updated Content

Beginning September 2020, ACT has announced new options for the assessment to offer students more choices and a better experience. These options have allowed us to completely revamp the student record data layout to replace the TXT files ACT has historically provided with a more flexible CSV file. The following outlines the new content within the CSV student record including the fields and descriptions of the data points. Each field in the CSV file will include double quote text qualifiers: "value". The file name format will be similar to the format already in place that includes the data source, organization name, and date/time stamp such as: ACT-SAMPLE-COLLEGE-09132020-204011.csv.



These documents outline the new CSV file format for ACT Score Reports in Encoura Data Lab. Each contains similar information in one of two formats (PDF/Excel). The Excel version will also include legacy values for those interested in seeing the changes between the current and future layouts. The sample file in the new CSV format must be opened as a CSV file to ensure no loss of leading zeros and other key formatting found when opening Excel files.
