


- Adaptability




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DECISION CRITERIA

- Seeks to ensure relevance and applicability
- Limits the inclusion of certain technologies
- Addresses the evolving sphere of EdTech

- Consists of four categories and thirty-seven segments
- Covers student life-cycle and supporting technology


Potential Changes

CLASSIFICATION CRITERIA


- Focuses on higher-level functions (in green)
- Emphasizes standalone solutions over bundled solutions
- Allows one-to-many classifications
- Addresses changes in segment functions



Landscape

SEGMENTS

- May change to reflect different importance of certain segments for student success
- May include additional segments for student success and instruction, etc.



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OPM

- Defines online program management (OPM) from a technology functional view
- Results in OPM's being identical to online course solutions (Udacity, etc.)



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OPM

- May not capture the nuance of the market
- May be better characterized by other aspects (services, consolidation, etc.)












